Eco-friendly	Made from environmentally friendly materials.	
Weatherproof	Resistant to various weather conditions.	
Weather-resistant	Long-term ability to withstand weather influences.

Primer / Gesso	Improves the adhesion of the paint to the painting surface.	

Texture paste	Increases the volume and changes the texture of the paint.
Drying retarder	Extends the drying time for further editing.

Acrylic paints are fantastic for hobby creations and easy to handle. For professional artists, however, they pose a challenge: because acrylic paints can absorb light due to their pigmentation, paintings often appear darker. Adding white or applying white layers can help, though.
