Chickens from concrete modelling clay

Instructions No. 2170

Difficulty: Beginner

Working time: 1 hour 30 Minutes

This pair of chickens is a great decoration for spring. In this tutorial we explain how to shape the chickens from concrete modelling clay.



- 1. Knead well 1000 g of concrete modelling mass per chicken. Set aside some of the mass for the comb and beak.
- 2. Form the shape of a butternut pumpkin with your hands.
- 3. Shape the comb and beak and fix them to the chickens with a modelling brush. Smooth the surface with your finger and a little water.
- 4. Once you are satisfied with the result, the mass must dry for at least 24 hours.
- 5. After the drying time, the chickens can be decorated with metal leaf. To do this, coat the surface with a little application milk, pick up the metal leaf with a brush and apply it where you want it.

6. After the milk has dried, remove any excess metal leaf with a bristle brush. Finally, coat the surface with finishing varnish.
