Beautiful decorations are wellness for the soul. With just a only few handicraft steps, the pretty sailing ship pendants can be quickly recreated.



Hobby fun with Napkin technique

In the first step the sails of the small boats are painted. The stamping foil is primed white

While it Handicraft paint dries, the fish, whales and seaweed are Napkin cut out of it. As soon as the lower unprinted layers of paper are Napkin removed, the motifs are applied with a brush and Napkin varnish glued to the stamping foil. The lacquer does not only serve as Handicraft glue a protective layer but seals the thin napkin paper with a protective layer.



The individual motifs can now be cut precisely together with the stamping foil. This Metallic foil is placed on a soft surface with the Napkin foil facing down. With embossing pens the small fish and whales can be modelled in a nice 3D look.

The finished underwater decoration is glued to the sails and finally the sails get that certain something with painted water bubbles and foaming waves.
