

Door wreath made from polystyrene balls with wool

Instructions No. 450

They look almost like snowballs Polystyrene balls when wrapped in wool. The result is a beautiful wreath that can be hung on the door or wall all winter as an unusual decoration.



instruction

- Wrap the Polystyrene balls with the different wool types and colours and fix it with Pins .
- Wrap some balls additionally with glitter cord, all others with Lurex crochet thread.
- Use the compass to draw a circle with a diameter of about 30 cm on Paper , arrange the wool balls on it.
- Divide the wire into matching pieces and connect the balls to it. For safety, fix them additionally with hot glue.
- Glue the snowflakes to the wreath from behind.
- Cut the loop tape to size, tie one of the suspensions to it and fix it to the wreath with a piece of wire bent into a cramp.
