

Firs from polystyrene cones

What could be better than an impressive home decoration that is homemade and at the same time takes little time? These pretty fir trees are conjured up in a few minutes and only needs little material. The great thing is: the little trees can also be made together with children.



And it's that easy:

First of all, take a **Polystyrene cone** in the desired size at hand. Make a glue dot with **hot glue** at the bottom of Polystyrene cone and start to wrap the wool cord **around** the cone. You should fix the string with hot glue in places to prevent it from slipping away later. In this way you can design the styrofoam pans in different sizes. Finally, a star is formed from **silver wire**, which should decorate the top of the Fir

Tip: To get evenly shaped stars, you can take a Cut out form to help you and bend the wire around the form.
