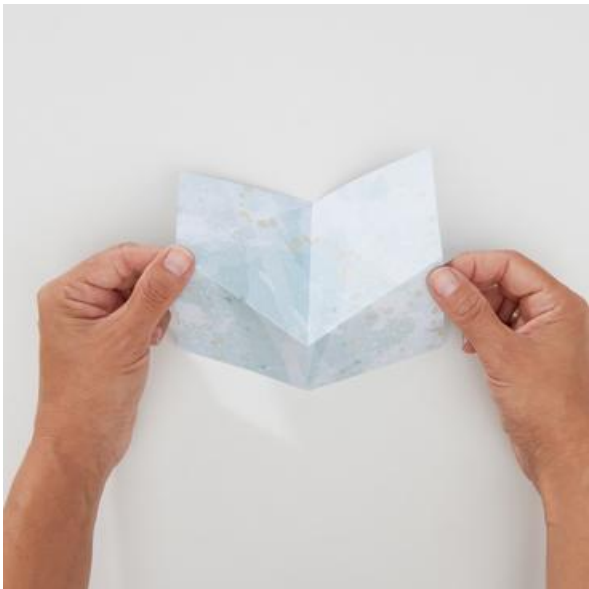

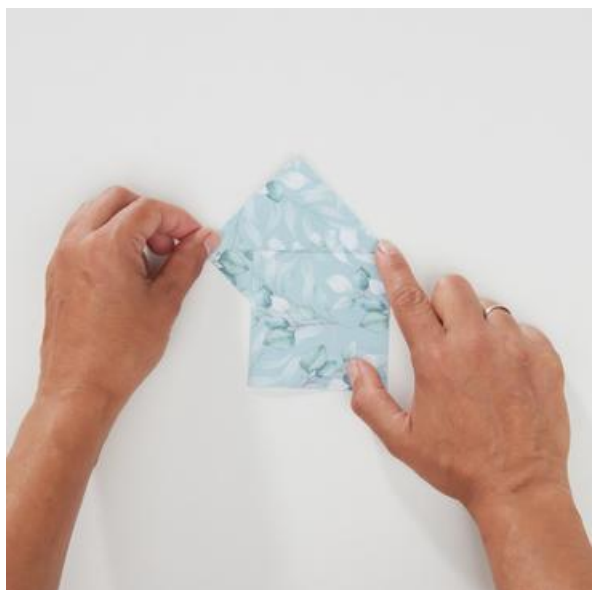


## Folding instructions for the windmill/star:

Folding instructions Take paper of your choice and fold it using our folding instructions:















Insert the **round bar** into the wooden ball. Put the rod through the star, shorten it to fit and put **wooden ball** on the end again.

Shorten the round bar to any length and insert it into the wooden disc. Put a wooden ball on the end. Apply hot glue to the top of the ball and place one of the wooden balls in the middle of the star.
