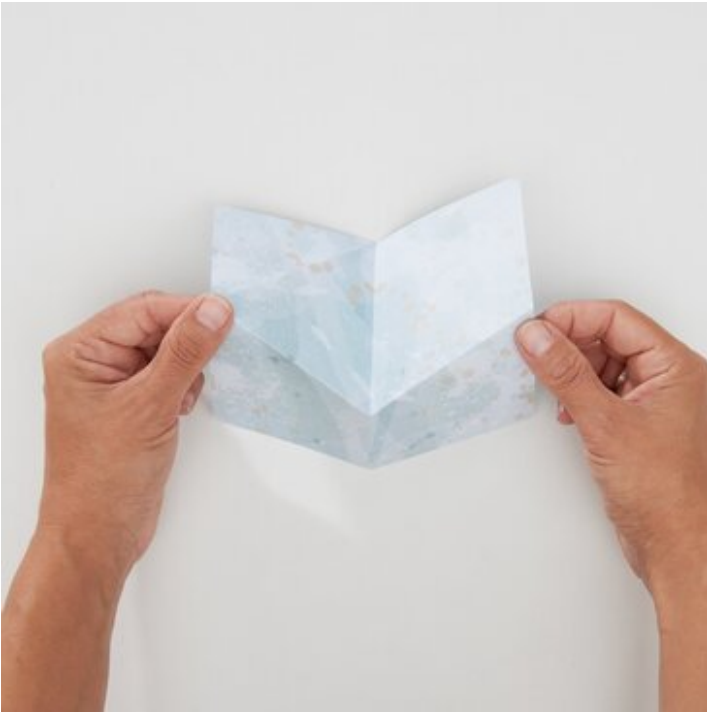
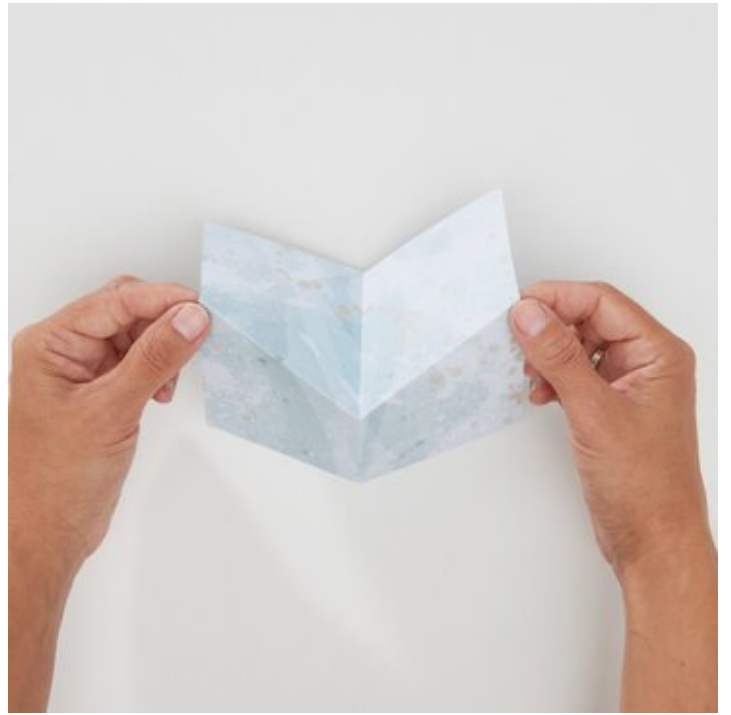

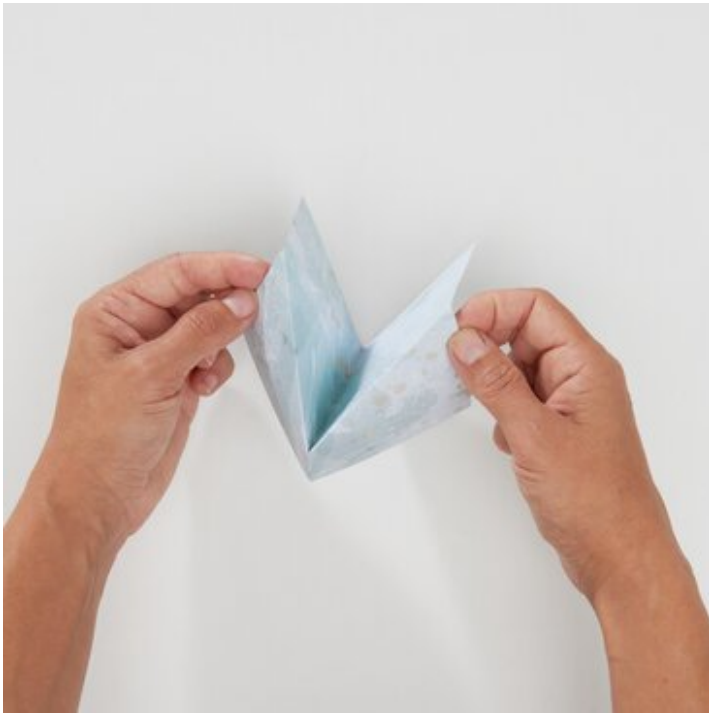


Folding instructions for the windmill/star:

Take the **papers of your choice** and fold them using our **folding instructions**:















Insert the **round rod** into the wooden ball. Insert the rod through the star, shorten it to fit and insert a **wooden ball** to the end

Shorten the round rod to any desired length and insert it into the wooden disk. Stick a wooden ball at the top of the end. Apply hot glue to the top of the ball and place one of the wooden balls in the middle of the star.
