Greeting card with bookmark

Instructions No. 647

This greeting card is designed with colourful wooden buttons and punched out paper buttons. It is also a nice souvenir for every bookworm: Under the cuff is a bookmark that can be removed.

Here's how it works

Cut the embossed cardboard approx. 21 x 42 cm and fold it into a card.

Cut the bookmark approx. 5 x 17 cm from the same cardboard and glue it to a slightly larger Paper from the block.

Glue two Paper strips of different widths around the card, leaving enough space on the front side to slide the bookmark under it.

Stick the lace with tape-Ribbon on the narrower stiffener.

Cut out butterflies from the paper block and stick them onto the card together with punched buttons. Then glue the wooden buttons with hot glue on the middle strip.

stick Satin ribbon with tape-Ribbon around the bookmark and glue the punched out buttons on the card.

Punch a hole in the top of the bookmark, thread through Satin ribbon and glue a button over it.


Finally, cut two narrow Paper strips to size and glue them on the card.
