between to maintain clear visibility.

Step 4: Reinforcing the engravings

After you've drawn the basic lines, you can use a thicker engraving pen to reinforce the patterns. This technique gives the engraving depth and clarity and reduces the risk of slipping.

Step 5: Finishing touches

Hold a black cloth or paper behind the glass to better detect small irregularities and correct them if necessary. Finally, thoroughly wash the glass to remove any remaining glass dust.


