Memoboard "Cactus"

Instructions No. 1635

JJJJJ Difficulty: Advanced

O Working time: 45 Minutes

You are looking for a great craft idea with practical use? This cactus is a great eye-catcher in the kitchen, at the workplace or next to the entrance door. It is cut very quickly with a scroll saw and then painted.



Sign - sawing - gluing - painting!

Two plywood boards of $50 \times 25 \text{ mm}$ each are required for the memoboard. Place them next to each other and draw the contours of your cactus with a pencil. Afterwards you saw out the cactus form with the scroll saw. In the next step you can process the remains of the plywood boards to further "ears" of the cactus form according to your personal taste. Now all the sawn out wooden parts are glued together.

Once the glue has dried, paint the wooden boards: The cactus is painted with black **Board paint** painted. The wood of the flowerpot should first be primed white. After drying, you paint the "pot" with pastel colour according to your personal taste

Practical!

The board can already be written on with chalk. Use hot glue to fix a few letter clips to the self-designed memo board - after all, this way you can easily clip small notes!
