

Moravian stars on wreath and card

Instructions No. 2897

Difficulty: Beginner 🍴🍴🍴🍴

Working time: 4 Hours

Moravian stars are beautiful and can be made in different ways so that they can be glued onto a card and a ring. A great decoration for the Christmas season!



This is how the card and wreath are made:

Fold the **moravian stars** according to the instructions. Six stars have a flat back so that you can glue them on. The hanging Froebel star in the ring has the 3D laces on both sides.

Stick one of the stars onto the **card** and decorate it discreetly as you like with the **Gelly Roll pens**.

Decorate the **wooden ring** with the remaining moravian stars and the wooden letters, which you paint with white craft paint beforehand. Glue them into the ring with hot glue.

Next, cut off a piece of wire. Thread it into a sewing needle and stick it vertically through the star. At the bottom, thread a 6 mm wooden bead and then a 4 mm wooden bead. Fold the wire once and pull it through the 6 mm wooden bead again. Tangle the end. Now you can string the three 4 mm beads on top. Tie the end of the wire to the top of the wooden ring.
