Pennant Invitation Cards

Instructions No. 2508

JJJJ Difficulty: Beginner

O Working time: 3 Hours

Fancy cards that are great to make as invitation cards for a birthday or garden party. With just a few materials and a few simple steps, you can create an **eye-catcher**.





Make the cards like this:

Transfer the **templates** to the **papers** and cut them out.

Use the folding board to emboss a folded edge on the smaller pennant shape. This is where the card will be folded later.

Round off the corners of the rectangle with apunch or scissors.

Glue the small pennant on the upper edge onto the large pennant. Attach two **wooden sticks** to the top edge of the pennant. Work a piece of the cord directly into the pennant. Glue the two ends of the cord between the sticks.

Thread a decorative **bead** over the loop.

Now you can decorate the cards as you like. For our cards, we chose a combination of punched out and written **lettering**.
