

Wall Decoration Cardboard Bunny

It's time to decorate your house and home for Easter. This **beautiful cardboard bunny** is easy to make and a great eye-catcher with the **dried flower bouquet**.



This is how the beautiful bunny is designed:

Download the **free template** and transfer it to **photo card** and **grey board**. Cut out the bunny. Cut the grey cardboard a little smaller so that you don't see the edges.

Tie the **dried flowers** into a bouquet. For the bow, first cut 5 pieces of the **jute ribbon**, lay them double and sew them. The first 3 bows are the same size. The ones above are a little smaller. You can vary the lengths according to the bouquet, to your own liking. Another long strip is laid double and glued to the back of the bow. Cut the tips at an angle. Tie the finished bow to the bouquet with a ribbon (it is best to pull the ribbon through the back with a needle).

Place the bouquet on the bunny and use a hole punch to punch holes where the bouquet is to be fixed. Tie with a ribbon.
