

Winter Flower Arrangement

Working time: 45 Minutes

With a **noble fir wreath**, you can create an **atmospheric Advent wreath** for your table or sideboard in no time. As you craft it, combine fir greenery with ornaments and pinecones to create your own personal look. An LED candle in the center provides warm light and makes the wreath suitable for everyday use. The result is a decoration that fits just as well with a modern, minimalist style as it does with a classic, cozy atmosphere.



Making an Advent Wreath

Decorating a Noble Fir Wreath as an Advent Wreath with an LED Candle Place the fir wreath on a sturdy surface and briefly plan the overall look: The LED candle will later sit in the center as a subtle focal point, while the festive abundance will be arranged around the outside. This way, your Advent wreath will retain a clean shape and won't look cluttered.

1. Trim the branches and create a clean base. Use side cutters to trim any branches that stick out or are too long. This ensures the wreath stays evenly round and that the decorations will stay in place later. Work your way all the way around until the outer edge looks balanced.

2. Determine the center: Place the LED candle Position the LED candle in the center of the wreath. The center is your reference point for the rest of the design.

3. Start with larger decorations: Secure the pinecones. Place the pinecones in the wreath as larger accents. Secure them with hot glue and press them down briefly until the glue sets. Placing the larger elements first helps you distribute the decorations evenly and fill in any gaps later on.

4. Incorporate the ornaments: Distribute highlights Next, glue the ornaments into the wreath using hot glue. Place them in small groups and repeat the arrangement around the candle to create a harmonious rhythm. Make sure the balls aren't just resting on top but are nestled slightly between the twigs—this makes the Advent wreath look more natural and helps the pieces stay in place better.

5. Finishing touches: Fill in gaps and align details Finally, add small twigs or delicate decorative elements until the surface appears solid. Align everything so that no glue spots are visible and the wreath's shape remains clean.

6. Styling tip for the finished Advent wreath If you're using the wreath as a table centerpiece, it looks especially beautiful on a plain background, because the greenery, natural tones, and the LED candle will then take center stage.
