
Zentangle drawing technique

The Zentangle Method

Zentangle is like drawing for relaxation. You might know the feeling of being absorbed in doodling during a phone call or other everyday situations. This relaxed yet focused drawing is the Zen aspect in Zentangle. The patterns you create are Tangles – abstract, intertwined lines. Zentangle doesn't require special skills, but provides room for relaxation and fun. Existing books and templates help you find creative ideas for your Zentangle. The variety of patterns gives the method structure, making it usable for both beginners and experienced artists.

How do I draw a Zentangle?



Zentangles are typically drawn on small tiles, known as Tiles. These tiles are made from thick artist paper, so the fineliner doesn't bleed through later. The process begins with sketching lightly with a <u>pencil</u>. Rulers and erasers are usually taboo, as the natural imperfections give each Zentangle its own character. If you still want to make corrections, <u>kneaded erasers</u> are a clean and flexible solution. They also help create shadows and depths for added structure.

Start by sketching your Zentangle lightly with a pencil. Then, go over it with a <u>Zentangle fineliner</u> – these are artist pens with a fine, highly pigmented ink, perfect for clean tracing. Finally, you can add color to your Zentangle with <u>colored pencils</u>. You can get even more variation with <u>black Tiles</u>, which you can decorate with <u>white pens</u>.
