## Sea-bylle Beach Bag

## SIZE

## Width

Approx. 56 cm

## Heigth (without handles)

Approx. 40 cm

## MATERIALS

Schachenmayr Catania Grande, 50 g ball
Color $50 \mathrm{~g}=63 \mathrm{~m}$
Color 03164 (Jeans) 6 balls
Color 03105 (Natur) 6 balls
Color 03254 (Taupe) 4 balls

Yarn amounts are approximate. Make sure to purchase enough of the same dye lot in order to complete your project. The colour names refer to the German names on the sleeves. The amount of yarn needed can vary from person to person

1 crochet hook 5,0 mm
1 crochet hook $7,0 \mathrm{~mm}$
1 tapestry needle yarn needle for weaving in ends

## GAUGE

Basic pattern: 13 sts and 8 rnds $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$
If your gauge differs from the given gauge, use a hook of a larger or smaller size accordingly.

## COLOR SEQUENCE

Rnds 1. - 15: Jeans
Rnd 16: Natur
Rnd 17: Jeans
Rnds 18 - 21: Natur
Rnd 22: Jeans
Rnd 23: Natur
Rnds 24-27: Jeans
Rnd 28: Natur
Rnd 29: Jeans

Rnds 30-33: Natur
Rnd 34: Jeans
Rnd 35: Natur
Rnds 36 - 39: Jeans
Rnd 40: Natur
Rnd 41: Jeans
Rnds 42-45: Natur
Rnds 46-47: Taupe
Tip: When changing colours, fasten off the last st with the new color to achieve a perfect color transition.

## BAISCS <br> Spiral rounds

Spiral rounds are not closed with 1 sl st, but are continuously worked in spirals.
This ensures that the round transition is invisible.
So as to be able to tell when one rnd ends, mark the end with a contrasting color.

## Basic pattern

Rnd 1: ch 3 ( $=1 \mathrm{dc}$ ), * sk 1, 2 dc in next st, rep continuously from *, end the rnd with 1 dc (in the sl st) and 1 sl st (in the 3rd ch).
2nd and every subsequent rnd: ch 3 (= 1 dc ), * 2 dc between the next two dc groups of previous rnd, rep continuously from *, end the rnd with 1 dc (makes 1 dc group with the first 3 ch ) and 1 sl st (in the 3 rd ch ).

## Crab stitch.

Work crab stitch in the sc from left to right: Insert hook in the 1st st to the right of the hook.
The working loop is in front of the stitch loops
Draw through the st. There are now 2 loops on the hook.
Draw through both loops.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Bag base

Loosely ch 50 in Jeans using crochet hook E/4 (5.0 mm).
1: 48 sc
working the 1st sc in the 2nd ch from hook. 3 sc in last st, then continue working the foundation chain on the back: 47 sc, 2 sc (in the same st as the 1st sc), close the rnd with 1 sl st in the 1st sc (= 100 st ).
2: ch 1 ( $=1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) +1 sc (in the same st as the sl st from the
previous rnd), $47 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc in each of the next 3 st, 47 sc, 2 sc
in each of the next 2 st, close the rad with 1 st st in the ch from the beginning of the rad (= 106 st ).
3: ch $1+1$ sc, 1 sc, $47 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{x}$ (double $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ ), 47 sc , $2 x$ (double $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ ), close the rad with 1 sl st in the ch from the beginning of the end (= 112 st ).
4: ch +1 sc, 2 sc, $47 \mathrm{sc}, 3 x$ (double $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ ), 47 sc , $2 x$ (double $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ ), close the rad with 1 sl st in the ch from the beginning of the rad (= 118 sts ).
5: ch $+1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}, 47 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \times($ double $1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ ) 47 sc , $2 x$ (double $1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ ), close the rad with 1 st st in the ch from the beginning of the rad (= 124 sts ).
6: ch +1 sc, 4 sc, $47 \mathrm{sc}, 3 x$ (double $1 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ ) 47 sc , $2 x$ (double $1 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ ), close the rad with 1 sl st in the ch from the beginning of the rad (= 130 sts ).
7: ch +1 sc, 5 sc, $47 \mathrm{sc}, 3 x$ (double $1 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{sc}$ ), 47 sc , $2 x$ (double 1 sc, 5 sc ), close the rad with 1 st st in the ch from the beginning of the rad (= 136 sts ).
8: ch +1 sc, 6 sc, $47 \mathrm{sc}, 3 x$ (double $1 \mathrm{sc}, 6 \mathrm{sc}$ ), 47 sc , $2 x$ (double $1 \mathrm{sc}, 6 \mathrm{sc}$ ), close the rad with 1 sl st in the ch from the beginning of the rad (= 142 sts ).
9: ch +1 sc, 7 sc, 47 sc, $3 x$ (double 1 sc, 7 sc), 47 sc, $2 x$ (double $1 \mathrm{sc}, 7 \mathrm{sc}$ ), close the rad with 1 sl st in the ch from the beginning of the rad ( $=148 \mathrm{sts}$ ).
10: ch 1 + 1 sc, 8 sc, $47 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{x}$ (double $1 \mathrm{sc}, 8 \mathrm{sc}$ ) 47 sc , $2 x$ (double $1 \mathrm{sc}, 8 \mathrm{sc}$ ) (= 154 sts).
Do not close this rad with 1 st st, instead continue working in spiral rounds:
11 - 15: Work 1 sc in every st, close the 15th rad with 1 st st.

## Basic pattern/Side sections:

16: ch 3 (= 1 dc ), * sk 1, 2 dc in next st, rep continuously from *, end the rad with 1 dc (in the st st) and 1 st st (in the 3rd ch).
17 - 45: ch 3 ( $=1 \mathrm{dc}$ ), * 2 dc between the next two dc groups of previous rad, rep continuously from *, end the rad with 1 dc (makes 1 dc group with the first 3 ch ) and 1 sl st (in the 3rd ch).
46: In Taupe ch 1 ( $=1 \mathrm{sc}$ ), then work 1 sc in every st, end the rad with 1 st st in the ch.
47: ch 1, then work 1 crab stitch in every st from left to right, end the rind with 1 sI st in the 1st crab stitch.

## Handles

To make the handles, work a total of 6 cords (3 per handle) as follows:
Loosely work a foundation chain 95 cm long with a double length of Taupe using crochet hook K/10.5 (7 mm).
Then work 1 sc in every st.
Draw through and fasten off the thread.

## FINISHING OFF

To make one handle, tie 3 cords together and then braid them:
To do this, thread each cord next to each other through every 1 dc gap in the 43 rd row of the bag approx. 15 cm from the upper edge. Knot all 3 cords together on the front. Braid the cords together on the inside of the bag, with 17 cm left, draw the individual cords through the dc gaps (from the inside out) and tie together on the front.
Make the 2 nd handle in the same way.
