# Kids cardigan Stella

Knitting pattern for girl cardigan in 3 sizes: **EU:** 98/104, 110/116 en 122/128. **US:** 4T, 6, 7 to 8. **UK:** 3-4, 5-6, 7-8.  
The sample is made in size 110/116, (6, 5-6)

## Yarn

Durable Furry, 100% polyester, 50g/35m,  
Color 225 Vintage pink: 6-7-8 skeins

## Materials

Knitting needles 8 mm / (US) 11  
Crochet hook 6 mm / (US) J  
Scissors, tapestry needle, stitch markers, measuring tape,  
5 buttons (Prym Creative, article number 312102)

## Abbreviations

sl- slip  
RS – right side  
WS – wrong side  
incr – increase  
M1 – increase by 1, knit in back and front loop of the stitch  
k – knit  
yo – yarn over  
garter stitch – knit all rows  
st(s) – stitch(es)  
5 buttonholes on the right front at the RS; k2, yo, sl 1, pass slipped 1 over.



## Gauge

10s x 12 rows knitted in garter stitch with knitting needle 8 mm = 10 x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

Beginner

## Clothing sizes

Size	98/104	110/116	122/128
Finished back width	31	33	35
Finished front width	17	19	20
Length	33	36	39
Sleeve Length	26	30	34
Sleeve width at the bottom	18	20	22
Sleeve width at the top	26	28	30

## Pattern info and tips

The cardigan is worked completely in garter stitch, in separate parts.

You can knit both fronts separately or at the same time. (make sure you knit the neck in mirror image).

At the fronts, stitches are cast off for a round neckline.

You can also knit the sleeves separately or at the same time. (if you knit them at the same time, you have the increases in the same place).

Afterward, the different parts (back, front and sleeves) are put together. Finish with the collar.

The increases of the sleeve and collar are made by knitting 2 stitches in the 1st and last st.

Mark the buttonholes and increases with a stitch marker: the distance between them will be more clear.

## Pattern

### Back:

With knitting needles 8mm:

Cast on 31s (33, 35) and knit in garter stitch to a height of 33 cm (36, 39). Bind off all the stitches.

### Front:

#### With knitting needles 8 mm / US 11:

Cast on for each front 17, (19, 20) st and knit all rows until a height of 23,5 (26,5, 29,5) cm, simultaneously knit the 5 buttonholes in the right front, evenly divided.

### Neck:

Bind off 4, (5, 5) front neck st

Bind off each 2nd row; 1 x 2 st, 2 x 1 st

(for the right front, this is in the forward rows, and in the left front in the returning rows).

Continue knitting until a height of 33 cm (36, 39) and bind off all remaining st.

### Sleeves;

#### With knitting needles 8 mm / US 11:

Cast on 18, (20, 22) st for each sleeve and knitt all rows.

Increase in each 6th row on both sides in the first and last st. Repeat this 4 times.

The sleeves will have 26, (28, 30) st total.

Knit until a height of 26, (30, 34) cm and bind off all the st.

### Finish:

Sew the seams at the back side. (Put the right sides together)

- close the shoulders
- sew the sleeves to the front and back
- close the sleeves and sides of front and back
- sew the buttons on the left front.

### Collar:

With knitting needles 8 mm / US 11;


Pick up 27, (29, 31) st along the neckline; starting at the front, 3 st, front the center, the st from the back and the st from the front again, leaving the last 2 st. Knit 2 rows.

Increase in the 3rd row in the first and last st. = 29, (31, 33) st

Knit 4 more rows and then bind off.

With crochet hook; crochet an edge of single crochet along the collar.

Weave in ends.
